

Unwanted cards

In July 2007 the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations were introduced to reduce the amount of untreated waste electrical and electronic equipment going to landfill.

If you have any piece of TV in a Card you want to recycle, you can send it directly to us at TV in a Card 5 Vallings Place, Long Ditton, Surrey KT6 5AZ. We will refund your 2nd class postage.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are recycling a product that holds any video please ensure that you copy this video to your computer prior to sending to us, as we may not be able to retrieve the video after receipt.

All TV in a Card products can be recycled! You can tell because our products include a 'crossed out wheeled bin symbol' like this. Even if your old TV in a Card product doesn't have the 'crossed out wheeled bin' symbol, we will accept and recycle all your TV in a Card products to the best of our ability.

Recycling unwanted products is better for the environment. Toxins contained in some goods can cause soil and water contamination. This can have a very harmful effect on the natural habitat, wildlife and also human health. When situated near populated areas these toxins can cause problems to communities as their water and soil is polluted. Many of the items that we throw away can be repaired or recycled.

Recycling items helps to save natural resources and also reduces the environmental and health risks associated with sending waste electrical goods to landfill.
